As we learn more about ourselves through our 'All About Me' topic we would like you to take some photographs of children's favourite things at home and upload them to

Tapestry. This could be a favourite book, a special toy, their pet, or family members etc. We will use the photographs as a focus for small group activities where we show our friends and learn more about each other.

Celebrations

As we learn more about ourselves we will also be exploring children's different home cultures, so if your family has any special cultural celebrations that are different to traditional English customs, or specific ways of celebrating, please let us know so we can include them in our planning.

Harvest

To celebrate the English festival of Harvest children are invited to bring in small food items for our Harvest table. We will pass on any donations to Counterslip Food bank. Please bring any food donations in during the weeks of **28th Sept – 2nd Oct.**

Natural Resources

During our Autumn topic we will be looking at seasonal changes in our world and we will be using lots of natural resources to enhance learning. If you are out and about and find conkers, leaves, fir cones or anything else that you think children would be interested in then please bring them into pre-school for us to use.

Please note as part of our Covid procedures any items brought into pre-school will either be sanitised or quarantined before children are exposed to them.

Out and About in the Community

As you are probably aware, at present we are unable to make visits into the community and we will advise parents when this changes.

Key Person Meetings

Meetings will be arranged for all children next term (9th – 13th Nov) to update parents on how children have settled in and their progress so far.

Packed Lunches

A reminder to parents that as part of our healthy eating policy we respectfully request that children do not bring chocolate bars or sweets in their lunch box. If children bring grapes, olives or tomatoes they need to be cut in half **lengthways** to avoid choking hazards. Please do not send in drinks as we provide drinks at lunchtime.

Hygiene

To prevent lunchtime staff having to handle children's food please make sure packets are opened and fruit is prepared ready for children to eat. Children need to be able to open containers themselves so they can be as independent as possible.

Celebrating Birthdays

We are happy for children to bring in one large cake or small cakes to share with friends to celebrate a birthday or special occasion. Due to current circumstances we can no longer share home made cakes but can accept shop bought cakes that are wrapped.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please use **the pre-school mobile number 07952929661** to report absences, check how your child is, or inform us if anyone different is collecting your child. Do not ring the landline number or email, as messages are not regularly picked up. This number is for queries regarding sessions, fees or out of hours information.

Emergency Contact Numbers

Please ensure that you are always available on the emergency contact number you have given us. We must **always** be able to get hold of someone in the event of an emergency. If you are not going to be available on the number you have given then please notify us when dropping off your child.

Safety

When queueing to enter pre-school please can parents wait along the path next to our building and not on the main path. We have had complaints that parents and school children have had to walk in the road as there is no room on the path. During busy school times this is proving a hazard.

Please make sure the black gate is **always** shut on entering and leaving to keep children safe.

Sunhats

Due to the nice weather all children need to bring in a sun hat to keep at pre-school as we are doing lots of outdoor play.

Coats - Every child must bring an outdoor coat with them to every session. We use the outdoor environment every day sometime for long periods and children need to be warm and dry. The British weather is very unpredictable so even on sunny days we may need it!

Toys from home

At the moment children are not able to bring in any items from home without prior permission.

Spare clothes bags

As mentioned at your key meeting please make sure bags contain at least 3 **FULL** sets of clothes and a spare pair of shoes.

Clothing

In order to help children be as independent as possible when using the toilet please could they wear suitable clothing such as leggings and jogging bottoms and not trousers with buttons or belts. Ideally shoes should have Velcro fastenings and be closed in to prevent trip hazards.

Pre-school Fees – Please note pre-school fees need to be paid **during the first week of the month** (unless you are paying by childcare credits). Bills have been late this month as we confirm details from the grant forms, but will normally be given on the first day of the month. If you are unable to pay at the beginning of the month or have any queries regarding your fees please ring Don on 0117-9774170 or 07905791950.
