

NEWSLETTER – School House Nov 2020

IMPORTANT - Pre-school will reopen on Monday at the later time of 9.30 to enable staff to meet and discuss new Covid arrangements. This was not possible during half term due to staff being in quarantine. We apologise for any inconvenience caused but feel this is extremely important to keep everyone safe.

Dear Parents,

We would like to welcome you back to the new term and to thank everyone for their support and get well wishes for staff and children at the end of last term. In total three staff members and three children tested positive for Covid 19, fortunately the staff only had minor symptoms and the children either had very minor symptoms or no symptoms at all. We hope that self-isolation over half term will stem any further infections in the setting.

As we have done this term, we will keep parents fully updated via email about any suspected or confirmed cases relating to children in the setting, but our experience has proved that the situation can move very rapidly so please check your emails regularly. As mentioned, we also found that children who tested positive were asymptomatic and showed little or no sign of being unwell but were tested because family members had symptoms. We would therefore ask that parents be vigilant in keeping their children away from pre-school **if any family members are ill, regardless of whether the child appears ill or not.** This is an important and effective way to prevent any possible spread of the virus and keep pre-school open.

We will continue to carry out stringent hygiene and cleaning procedures within the setting but to further protect everyone we will be introducing the following measures from this next term:

- Parents need to wear a face mask when dropping and collecting their child
- Parents must keep well back from the door
- No backpacks or items from home can be brought into pre-school
- Staff will wear masks and gloves when answering the door
- Staff are no longer able to take crying children from parents. Staff will provide a hand to hold and encouragement but we cannot carry children into the setting
- Parents are asked to ensure they social distance from other parents and children whilst waiting to enter
- If family members are ill children must not attend the setting until the family member is well or tests negative for Covid 19

Please do not hesitate to contact Karon by email or telephone if you would like further details of our Covid procedures and we hope that they will enable us all to stay safe and well this term.

Harvest – A big thank you to everyone who supported our Harvest food collection last term which was taken to Counterslip Church Foodbank to help feed local families in need. They are seeing a big increase in demand and were extremely grateful for all your donations.

Garden Developments - I am sure you have noticed our new outdoor climbing equipment and decking which has been a big hit with all the children. They thoroughly enjoyed watching it all being constructed and are now enjoying practising their physical skills on a daily basis. The decking area will provide extra play space when it is very wet and we will be using the planters to grow fruit and vegetables throughout the year to support healthy eating.

During this term we will be using child centred activities and books to celebrate various festivals including **Bonfire Night** and **Diwali** and we will also be commemorating **Remembrance day**.

Sound of the Week – Starting this term we will be introducing a weekly phonic sound as detailed above. Each week we will be exploring a letter sound through fun phonic songs and activities and will be giving children the opportunity to go on

'sound hunts' around the setting. You can support your child to learn phonics at home by helping them to find items that begin with the sound of the week and by playing simple 'I Spy' games. When introducing children to phonics it is useful to remember to use the '*sound*' that the letter makes and not the letter name, but if you would like more information then please speak to your child's key person.

Story of the Week – To support children's literacy development we will be continuing to explore a specific story each week as detailed above. Through revisiting a familiar story children are able to develop pre-reading skills and enhance their own creative storytelling. You can support your child by reading our story of the week or asking them to retell the story to you.

Marble Jar – Over the last few weeks your child may have told you they have 'put a marble in the jar' which is another way we use to reward children. Whenever a child is kind, helpful or has worked to achieve their best they are rewarded by adding a marble to our jar. When the marble jar is full the whole group has a treat and the treat is decided by the children. If your child tells you they've been able to put a marble in the jar be sure to give them lots of praise!

Parent Key Person Consultations - Key person consultations will be held a week later than planned due to the closure before half term. Your key person will be in touch via Tapestry to arrange a telephone or zoom meeting with you to discuss how your child has settled in and their progress during the first term. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Dress Code – In order for children to develop self-help skills and gain confidence in looking after themselves please dress children in clothing that they can easily manage themselves. Trousers and leggings that can be easily pulled up and down are best for accessing the toilet and preventing accidents. It is also essential that children have warm outdoor clothing to wear **every day** as they will be accessing outdoor learning at some point during the day. Children need to have suitable footwear for running and climbing, and coats to ensure they are kept warm and dry.
