GROWING

WARLEIGH LODGE FARM

On Thurs 2nd May we would like to invite all children to accompany us to Warleigh Lodge Farm near Bath. We have visited the farm several times before and it is a wonderful experience for the children. It is a working farm which is not open to the public but only accepts school parties. During the visit we will explore the farm, feed chickens & cows, collect eggs, bottle feed lambs and have a tractor ride. You can view photos of farm activities on the Warleigh Lodge Facebook page. STEM

Although we weave science. engineering, and technology maths into learning our throughout the year, we have decided to make it a feature of our week to promote curiosity and wonder, as well as providing children with plenty of opportunities to explore this area of the curriculum in more detail. We are hoping to invite members of our community with background into our settings, so if you know of anyone that would like to support us with this project. please get in touch.

Home - School Link You can support children's learning at home by giving them lots of outdoor experiences and doing simple planting and gardening activities together and exploring the wildlife in your garden.

Sun safety - All children need to arrive at pre-school with sunscreen already applied. Staff will reapply sunscreen to children staying all day at lunchtime but do not have time to apply cream when children arrive. Sunshines will provide a hypoallergenic children's sunscreen but if your child is allergic to suncream please see a member of staff and we will make arrangements for your child to have their own. We will be using Sunshine sun hats for outside play so there is no need for children to bring their own.



SELF-HELP SKILLS

As lots of children will be leaving us soon to move on to school we will be working on children's self-help skills during the next two terms. You can support your child by encouraging them to dress themselves independently and make sure they wear suitable clothes and footwear to enable them to be independent whilst at pre-school. During snack times and at lunchtime we will be encouraging children to be as independent as possible with opening their own food items and making healthy choices. Please support child vour bv providing suitable wrappings and containers that they can easily open themselves.

FOOTWEAR

As the weather (hopefully) warms up it will not be appropriate for children to wear pre-school wellington boots when playing outside or going on walks in the community. We would therefore ask you to make sure your child wears suitable footwear to keep themselves safe. Please do not send them in open toed sandals or crocs as these are not suitable for running and climbing in the garden or when walking. Please make out children have correctly fitting shoes as this causes us lots of problems when children are using the walking rope.

SCHOOL PLACES FOR SEPTEMBER

Please let us know which school your child has been allocated so we can use the information to group children together who will be going to the same school and to let parents know who their child will be going to school with. Please advise staff when dropping or collecting your child.

Lunchboxes - Please remember due to health and safety issues we cannot allow 'tube' yoghurts at pre-school.

Entrance Gate - The black entrance gate to pre-school must always remain closed to maintain the safety of children so please make sure you close it behind you each time you enter or leave the premises.
