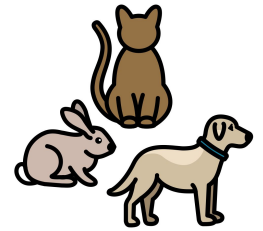
**HOLIDAY CLUB** - We will be running our holiday club at our Whitchurch setting over the Summer holidays (21st July - 13th August) again this year.

We are revisiting the above sounds as these are the phonic sounds older children will use when they start school. Please support your child by looking for items at home beginning with the sound of the week.

**Sun Safety** – To help us access the outdoors safely and efficiently please remember: **All children need to come with sunscreen already applied every day** even if the weather is not sunny in the morning. Staff will reapply sunscreen to children staying all day after lunch. This is very important, as we will be doing lots of outdoor activities and children need to be protected even on cloudy days.

Children do not need sun hats at preschool as they use Sunshine hats. Please also make sure children wear clothes that cover their shoulders ie no strappy tops, and wear enclosed, fitted shoes as open toed sandals and crocs pose health and safety issues.

**New Schools** – A list of who is going to which school is on the parents' noticeboard for your information. We will be supporting a positive transition to school through a range of activities and have invited all schools to visit the children at pre-school. Transition forms have been completed by your child's key person and will be passed on to school to give an overview of where they are in their development. Schools will be soliciting parents views using their own transition arrangements but if you have any concerns about your child going to school then please do not hesitate to speak to your key person.

**Tapestry** - To further enhance our transition procedures, and help support children and families who are moving on to a new school, children's Tapestry accounts will remain live until the end of September. This means you will be able to continue to upload photos or comments about what your child has been up to over the summer and when they start school. Staff will respond on return in September to keep the secure bond children have with Sunshines. More information will be made available about how to download your Tapestry account nearer the time.
